- Posters are displayed in the lunch area on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. The Tuesday evening reception will feature the **CASCON 2025 Poster Lightning Talks** and Best Posters Awards.

- Tuesday, November 11, 12:00-13:00 — Lunchtime Poster Presentations
- Tuesday, November 11, 18:00-20:00 — Reception Poster Lightning Talks & Presentations
- Wednesday, November 12, 12:00-13:00 — Lunchtime Poster Presentations

Each poster is allocated four time slots, in which we ask the poster presenters to accompany their posters. Prepare a quick pitch about your poster to spark interest and kick off discussions. One of the four time slots will be during the CASCON 2025 Posters Reception on Tuesday evening, Nov 1, 18:00-20:00. We understand that a slot might clash with other commitments. Still, please try to attend your own poster as much as possible to give the audience an excellent poster session experience.

Bring your own poster

Please print and bring your own poster to IEEE CASCON 2025. CASCON will provide Poster Boards.

Poster size

The recommended size for your printed poster is the standard poster size with a width of 36" (92 cm) and a height of 48" (122 cm). Your printed poster must not be larger than the standard poster size.

Poster setup and tear down

Poster setup is on Mon or Tue morning, Nov 10/11. Collect your poster by Wed, Nov 12 at 17:00.
