Focus ... who are you serving?


 The goal of this research is to aid [stakeholder] to [what is the problem] by [your research approach]

Example: The goal of this research is to aid <u>software</u> developers to <u>prioritize their security vulnerability</u> detection efforts by the development of an <u>attack</u> surface approximation using metrics developed from stack traces from crash dumps.




Be impeccable with your research plan ... solicit feedback




Be modest and up front: Limitations and threats to validity



Share data and tools (if possible)




Enable replication



Pace yourself ... let the work ripen






Require drafts from your students **EARLY**!!




... or don't allow them to put your name on the paper.




On Reviewer #2: Hanlon's Razor

Constantly keep abreast of latest research/literature




Review other's papers

Help people and they will help you back:D


Read your paper aloud






Practice cooperation, not competition with colleagues in the same field ... and your new faculty colleagues
